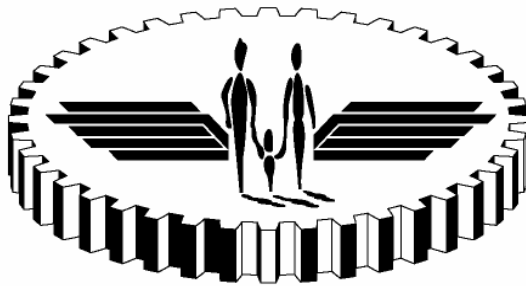

A Home Safety Checklist

EMERGENCIES

1. Are there emergency phone numbers posted by the telephone? YES NO
2. Is your home address posted by the telephone? YES NO
3. Are your house numbers visible from the street? YES NO
4. Has your family practiced an emergency escape plan? YES NO
5. Do escape windows open easily? YES NO
6. Do household members know the location of and how to operate the fire extinguishers in your home? YES NO
7. Do you inspect the fire extinguishers regularly? YES NO
8. Do you have a stocked emergency disaster kit for your family and pets? YES NO

THROUGHOUT THE HOUSE

1. Do you have a well-stocked, conveniently located first-aid kit? YES NO
2. Are prescription drugs, poisons, and chemicals properly labeled and stored in a safe place out of the reach of children? YES NO
3. Have all outdated prescriptions been discarded? YES NO
4. Are all stairways equipped with handrails? YES NO
5. Are all electrical cords and power strips the proper type, UL Listed, and in good condition? YES NO
6. Have you avoided running extension cords and power strips
 - Under the carpets or rugs? YES NO
 - Behind wall paneling? YES NO
 - Behind radiators? YES NO
 - Above door jambs and across thresholds? YES NO
7. Does your home have a working smoke detector
 - In the hallway near bedrooms? YES NO
 - In the kitchen YES NO
 - On every floor in the house? YES NO
8. Are your portable heaters approved by a recognized testing laboratory such as Underwriters Laboratory (UL) or Factory Mutual (FM)? YES NO
9. Do your portable heaters turn off when tipped over? YES NO
10. Do you have a working Carbon Monoxide detector in your house? YES NO
11. Are circuit panel breakers properly labeled?
 - Is the circuit panel easily accessible? YES NO
12. Are combustible materials a safe distance from heat-producing appliances and products?

13. Is tall / heavy furniture braced to prevent tipping? YES NO

A Home Safety Checklist

KITCHEN

1. Are small appliances unplugged when not in use?
2. Are the stove fan filter and hood clean?
3. Are pot handles turned away from the edges of the stove during cooking?

LIVING ROOM AND FAMILY ROOM

1. Does the fireplace have a proper screen or doors?
2. Is the chimney cleaned and inspected annually?
3. Is your woodstove cleaned and inspected annually?

BATHROOM

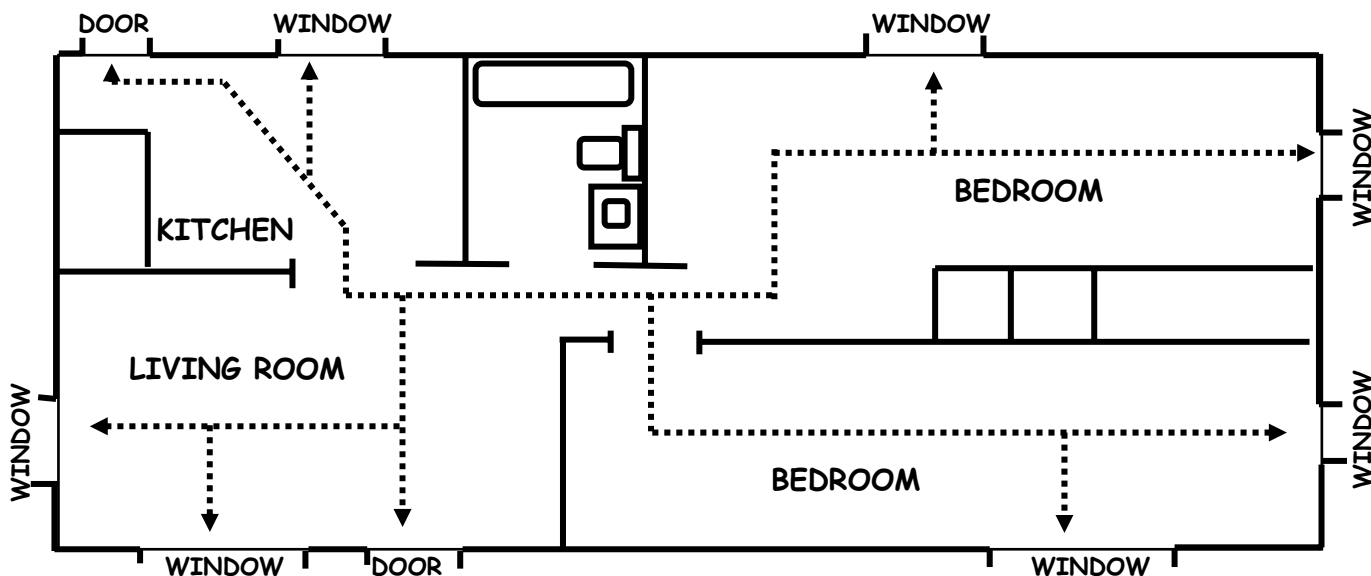
1. Are all electric appliances kept a safe distance from the sink and bathtub?
2. Are the receptacles GFCI?
3. Are hair dryers and curling irons kept unplugged when not in use?

BEDROOM

1. Do you keep your bedroom doors closed at night?
2. Have you established an evacuation route for every bedroom in your house?
3. Do you have escape ladders in every upper story bedroom?

UTILITY ROOM / GARAGE

1. Is the clothes dryer properly vented?
 - Do you keep the lint screen clean?
2. Is the water heater set at 130 degrees Fahrenheit or lower?
 - Is it free from leaks?
 - Is it braced to prevent tipping?
3. Is the furnace serviced regularly?
4. Is there a self-closing solid-core door between the garage and the residence?
5. Do you have an emergency kit with each auto?
