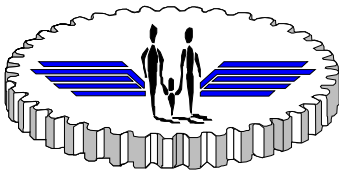


Do you know a *Safety Champion?*

The Safety Champion process is a concept developed between the IAM/Boeing Health & Safety Institute (HSI) and Safety, Health & Environmental Affairs (SHEA). The process is a simple and sincere way to thank and recognize a co-worker(s) or team for the safe choices they make or assistance that they've given when you or others were in need. Perhaps it's just someone you've seen wearing all the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment when they could have easily chosen not to do so. Perhaps it's someone who has shared some excellent safety information/training or maybe provided first aid. It might be someone who fought to change an unsafe process or has lead stretching exercises in your area. The significance of the event is not nearly as important as the fact that we so often overlook and forget to say "thanks for doing your job right," or "thanks for doing your job in a safe manner." Each safety Champion recipient will receive a formal thank-you, a safety champion lapel pin, a certificate of appreciation, and a possibility for us to share the story with the Executive Safety Council. If you know someone, or a group that is deserving, take a moment to fill out the form on the back and send it in. We will review it for authenticity and then take care of the rest. Thank you for recognizing those who make the Boeing Wichita Division a healthier and safer place to work.
